WORK DESCRIPTION

This project is part of the Affordable Housing and Sustainable Communities (AHSC) state grant, Round 3. The project will reduce greenhouse gas emissions and improve mobility by providing Sustainable Transportation Infrastructure (STI) and Transit Related Amenities (TRA). AHSC Round 3 Path Villas Improvements project includes sidewalk and curb ramp reconstruction, construction of pedestrian refuge island, high visibility crosswalks, installation of bike lanes, bike boxes, bike-friendly striping and signage, street tree planting and upgraded street lighting. Additionally, the project involves improvements to bus stop shelters and benches.

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DESIGN AND FUNDING

The plans and specifications were prepared by the City of Los Angeles, Bureau of Engineering’s Street Improvement Division (SID) and David Evans and Associates, Inc. The funding for this project is from the AHSC grant funding reimbursement and will be front funded by the LADOT Transportation Grant Fund, and SB1 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation CTIEP Fund.

The City has complied with the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (Public Resource Code, Sec. 21000 et. sec.) for the project.

CONTRACT BONDS

A "Bid Bond" is required. The successful bidder shall provide two good and sufficient surety bonds. The "Payment Bond" and "Performance Bond" shall each be for not less than 100 percent of the contract Price.

CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE CLASSIFICATION

At the time of bid, the contractor must possess a valid State of California Contractor's License Classification of "A".

PROJECT LABOR AGREEMENT

This project is subject to the provisions of the Department of Public Works Project Labor Agreement in Part IV of the Bid Proposal.

LOCAL BUSINESS PREFERENCE PROGRAM

This project is subject to the provisions of the City’s Local Business Preference Program. Los Angeles Administrative Code Division 10, Chapter 1, Article 4, Section 10.25 adopted the Local Business Preference (LBP) Program which was designed to increase local employment and expenditures in the local private sector. All Bidders are eligible to participate in the LBP Program. The City shall grant a six percent (6%) bid reduction of their Bid amount solely for Bid evaluation purposes to those bidders who are certified as a Local Business Enterprise (LBE) firm. If the LBE is also a Local Small Business (LSB) and/or Local Transitional Employer (LTE), they may be granted an additional two percent (2%) reduction for each of those certifications, up to a total of ten percent (10%). The City shall grant a ten percent (10%) bid reduction of their Bid amount solely for Bid evaluation purposes to those Bidders who are certified as a City Business Enterprise (CBE) firm. If the CBE is also a LSB and/or LTE, they may be granted an additional two percent (2%) reduction for each of those certifications, up to a maximum of twelve percent (12%). Additionally, all non-LBE/CBE Bidders may be granted a one percent (1%) bid reduction of their Bid amount solely for Bid evaluation purposes, up to a maximum of five percent (5%), for every ten percent (10%) of their bid that is to be performed by a LBE, CBE, LSB and/or LTE subcontractor.
