

## Bureau of Street Lighting

### Community Development Block Grant Funded Projects (CDBG)

June 7, 2024

The Bureau of Street Lighting (BSL) currently has 8 CDBG projects in the design and construction stage. These projects will install new street lighting systems in low to moderate income communities of the City that have no existing street lighting systems. The construction of these projects is contingent on the majority of affected property owners agreeing to pay annually for the maintenance of the new lighting system via ballot measure in compliance with Proposition 218. The following is a list of current CDBG funded projects within BSL.

#### Projects with a successful LD in compliance with Proposition 218

##### **1. San Pedro Area 4 Street Lighting**

- Council District 15
- CDBG funding: \$761,966
- **Reprogrammed \$707,148**
- Install 36 Streetlights
- **Anticipated Construction Start Date: Spring 2025**

##### **2. North Hollywood-Morella Street Lighting CDBG**

- Council District 6
- CDBG funding: \$1,203,751
- **Reprogrammed \$1,122,159**
- Install 48 Streetlights
- **Anticipated Construction Start Date: Spring 2025**

##### **3. Beacon Street Lighting Project**

- Council District 15
- CDBG funding: \$193,750
- **Reprogrammed \$162,656**
- Install 5 Streetlights
- **Anticipated Construction Start Date: Fall 2024**

#### **4. San Pedro-Grand Street Lighting**

- Council District 15
- CDBG funding: \$643,751
- **Reprogrammed \$568,580**
- Install 22 Streetlights
- **Anticipated Construction Start Date: Winter 2024**

#### **5. North Hollywood Area 3 Street Lighting**

- CDBG funding: \$840,706
- **Reprogrammed \$739,261**
- Install 35 Streetlights
- **Anticipated Construction Start Date: Spring 2025**

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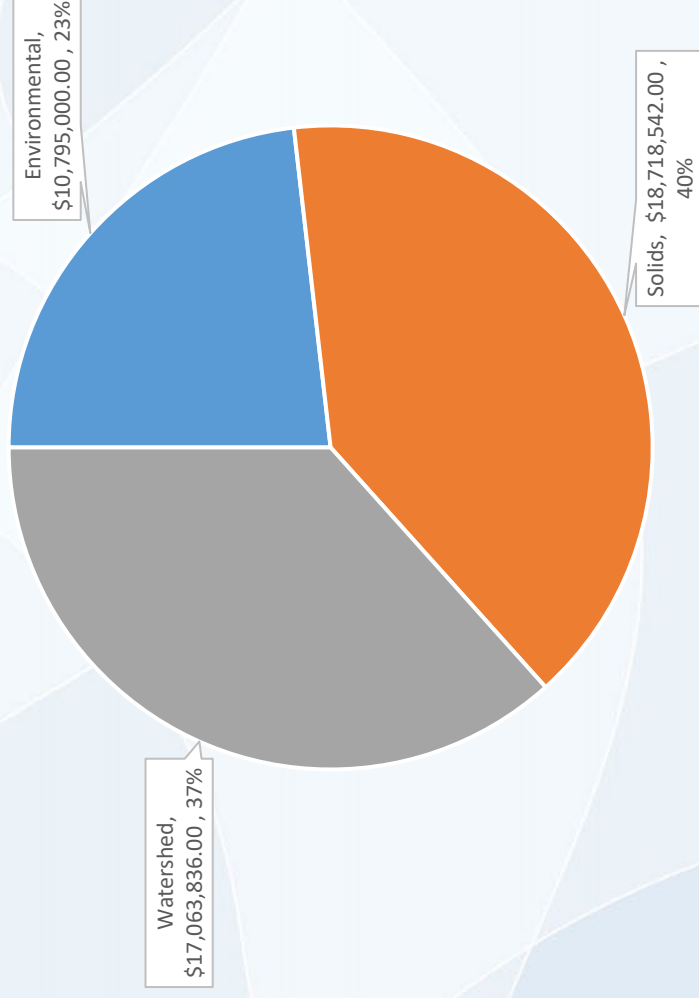
