NOTICE TO BIDDERS

The bid documents for this project will be issued through the City of Los Angeles (CLA) Regional Alliance Marketplace for Procurement (www.RAMPLA.org). Refer to the section entitled "Bid Documents" in this "Project Description" for information on how to obtain these bid documents.

WORK DESCRIPTION

This project is a Design Bid Build construction project to remediate existing pedestrian facilities (sidewalk and curb ramp) into compliance with current disability access standards (ADA) at 26 sites per Contract Documents. Other work may include: driveway replacement, curb/curb & gutter replacement, asphalt concrete replacement, tree root pruning, tree canopy pruning, tree removal and planting, utility box/vault/meter/maintenance hole adjustment, Street Lighting pull box relocation, PVC pipe removal and replacement, sidewalk culvert and irrigation system replacement, concrete alley and pavement replacement, street sign and mailbox replacement.

DESIGN AND FUNDING

The City has complied with the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (Public Resource Code, Sec. 21000 et. sec.) for the project.

CONTRACT BONDS

A "Bid Bond" is required. The successful bidder shall provide two good and sufficient surety bonds. The "Payment Bond" and "Performance Bond" shall each be for not less than 100 percent of the contract Price.

CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE CLASSIFICATION

At the time of bid, the contractor must possess a valid State of California Contractor's License Classification of "A".

BID DOCUMENTS

LOCAL BUSINESS PREFERENCE PROGRAM

This project is subject to the provisions of the City's Local Business Preference Program. Los Angeles Administrative Code Division 10, Chapter 1, Article 4, Section 10.25 adopted the Local Business Preference (LBP) Program which was designed to increase local employment and expenditures in the local private sector. All Bidders are eligible to participate in the LBP Program. The City shall grant a six percent (6%) bid reduction of their Bid amount solely for Bid evaluation purposes to those bidders who are certified as a Local Business Enterprise (LBE) firm. If the LBE is also a Local Small Business (LSB) and/or Local Transitional Employer (LTE), they may be granted an additional two percent (2%) reduction for each of those certifications, up to a total of ten percent (10%). The City shall grant a ten percent (10%) bid reduction of their Bid amount solely for Bid evaluation purposes to those Bidders who are certified as a City Business Enterprise (CBE) firm. If the CBE is also a LSB and/or LTE, they may be granted an additional two percent (2%) reduction for each of those certifications, up to a maximum of twelve percent (12%). Additionally, all non-LBE/CBE Bidders may be granted a one percent (1%) bid reduction of their Bid amount solely for Bid evaluation purposes, up to a maximum of five percent (5%), for every ten percent (10%) of their bid that is to be performed by a LBE, CBE, LSB and/or LTE subcontractor.
