MOTION

The **Walk Pico! A Catalyst for Community Vitality and Connectivity, Federal Project No. CML-5006(862) (Work Order No. M0014990)** (Project) was advertised on January 12, 2024, with bids to be received by February 21, 2024. The Project consists of pedestrian lighting and traffic signal improvements in the City of Los Angeles (City) that focus on safety improvements for pedestrians and bicyclists. These improvements include the installation of a new traffic and bicycle signal and pedestrian lighting at bus zones. The City Engineer's estimate for the Project is \$819,724.

On February 21, 2024, the Board of Public Works (Board) received two bids for the Project which were 31.61 and 135.58 percent higher than the City Engineer's estimate. The Bureau of Street Services (BSS) has reviewed the bids and has deemed them high since they significantly exceed the City Engineer's estimate. As such, it is in the best interest of the City to reject all bids. The BSS will instead utilize City forces to reduce cost and the BSS will not need to re-advertise the Project.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Board reject all bids for the Project.
