METRO WESTSIDE PURPLE LINE EXTENSION PROJECT, SECTIONS 1, 2 AND 3 - REQUEST TO PERFORM CONSTRUCTION WORK DURING THE 2022 HOLIDAY SEASON STREET CLOSURE RESTRICTIONS AND PEAK TRAFFIC HOURS (WORK ORDER NOS. E1907395, E1907871 AND E1908040)

RECOMMENDING THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS (BOARD):

1. CONSIDER and APPROVE or DENY the Holiday Moratorium Exemption requests, as detailed in the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro)'s correspondence (Transmittal Nos. 1, 2 and 3), to allow construction work during the 2022 Holiday Season Street Closure Restrictions (November 23-27, December 2-4, December 9-11 and December 16-25, 2022) in the vicinity of the following areas:

Purple Line Extension (PLE), Section 1: La Brea Station, Fairfax Station,
Western Retrieval Shaft, and Tunnel work along Wilshire Blvd.

PLE, Section 2: Century City Constellation Station

PLE, Section 3: UCLA Station

2. CONSIDER and APPROVE or DENY the Peak Hour Exemption requests, as detailed in Metro's correspondence (Transmittal Nos. 1, 2 and 3), to allow construction work during Peak Traffic Hours, as needed, Monday through Friday, AM Peak Hours (6:00 am to 9:00 am) and PM Peak Hours (3:30 pm to 7:00 pm) during the following periods:

PLE, Section 1: November 21, 2022 to January 1, 2023

PLE, Section 2: November 23, 2022 to January 3, 2023

PLE, Section 3: November 23, 2022 to December 22, 2022

3. SPECIFY that the Metro Transit Division of the Bureau of Engineering (BOE), located at 1149 South Broadway, the Board, located at 200 North Spring Street, and other relevant City of Los Angeles (City) departments are custodians of the documents or other material which constitute the record of the proceedings upon which the Board's decision is based.

CONDITIONS

1. Pursuant to the City and the Metro Master Cooperative Agreement (MCA), City Contract No. C-104288, and Joint Report No. 1 - Westside PLE Special Permitting Process, adopted August 20, 2014, associated permit fees shall be waived.

2. Permittees shall obtain all necessary approvals for construction work to be performed during the requested Holiday Moratorium and Peak Hour Exemptions (Recommendation Nos. 1 and 2).
3. All construction lane closures shall follow the Los Angeles Department of Transportation approved Worksite Traffic Control Plans.

TRANSMITTALS

1. Letter from Metro, dated November 10, 2022, requesting a Holiday Moratorium and Peak Hour Exemption to perform construction work, including tunnel support and construction at the Wilshire/Fairfax Station, Wilshire/La Brea Station, Western Shaft, and monitoring instrumentation maintenance along the PLE Project, Section 1, alignment.
2. Letter from Metro, dated November 10, 2022, requesting a Holiday Moratorium and Peak Hour Exemption to perform construction work, including station excavation and various utility installations, for the PLE Project, Section 2, Constellation Ave Station.
3. Letter from Metro, dated November 10, 2022, requesting a Holiday Moratorium and Peak Hour Exemption to perform construction work, including excavation, decking and utility relocations, for the PLE Project, Section 3, UCLA Station.

DISCUSSION

Background

In accordance with the Board's policy, lane closures are prohibited during the holiday season on certain City streets to minimize the impact on shoppers and retail businesses. The 2022 Holiday Season Moratorium is in effect on: November 23-27, December 2-4, December 9-11, and December 16-25, 2022. Per established procedures, holiday restrictions may be waived with concurrence of the applicable City Council District Office.

In accordance with Los Angeles Municipal Code 62.61, a permit is required to implement lane closures or perform work on City streets during Peak Traffic Hours which are defined as Monday through Friday, AM Peak Hours (6:00 am to 9:00 am) and PM Peak Hours (3:30 pm to 7:00 pm). Per established procedures, Peak Hour Exemption requests require that applicants seek concurrence from the applicable City Council District office.

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The requested Holiday Moratorium and Peak Hour Exemptions are detailed in Metro's correspondence (Transmittal Nos. 1, 2 and 3). The requested work areas are summarized below:

PLE, Section 1 (Council District Nos. 5, 10 and 13)

- La Brea Station area near Wilshire Boulevard at La Brea Avenue
- Fairfax Station area near Wilshire Boulevard at Fairfax Avenue
- Western Retrieval Shaft near Wilshire Boulevard, east of Western Avenue
- Tunnel work along Wilshire Boulevard, from Western Avenue to San Vicente Boulevard

PLE, Section 2 (Council District No. 5)

- Constellation Station on Constellation Boulevard, between Century Park East and Century Park West
- Tunnel work at Century Park East, between Constellation Boulevard and Santa Monica Boulevard

PLE, Section 3 (Council District No. 5)

- UCLA Station area on Wilshire Boulevard, between Westwood Boulevard and Gayley Avenue

In accordance with established procedures, Metro has sought concurrence from the affected City Council District Nos. 5, 10 and 13. Council District Nos. 10 and 13 support granting the 2022 Holiday Moratorium Exemption request for the east end of PLE, Section 1, however, Metro has not been able to secure the support of Council District No. 5 (Transmittal No. 1).

Community Outreach Statement

The Metro Construction Relations team will be updating the projects' stakeholders of the construction work during the Holiday Moratorium and Peak Traffic Hours, subject to Board approval, through community meetings, emails, phone calls, and various social media outlets. In addition, the Metro Construction Relations team will:

1. Create and distribute updated construction notices through the following channels:
 - Eblast
 - Website
 - Social Media
 - Direct outreach, including emails and phone calls, will be done to major stakeholders along the alignment.
2. Provide a digital traffic message board, a minimum of one week prior to the event, informing drivers of the change.

**Holiday Moratorium and Peak Hour Exemption Permit Application:
Westside PLE Section 1**

Metro is currently constructing Section 1 of the WPLE Project that will extend the Purple Line Subway from the existing Wilshire/Western Station to new underground stations at Wilshire/La Brea, Wilshire/Fairfax and Wilshire/La Cienega.

As part of the street closure process, Metro, and its Contractor (STS) are required to obtain City of Los Angeles Board of Public Works approval for exceptions to the City of Los Angeles Holiday Moratorium. This letter represents STS's request for a Holiday Moratorium and Peak Hour Exemption for work in Section 1. This work includes tunnel support as well as construction, excavation, and maintenance at the Western, La Brea and Fairfax stations.

Council District 5 has informed us that it will not be approving any requests for permits for Metro projects.

In regard to outreach and engagement with the community for work during the Holiday Moratorium, Metro will conduct the following.

1.A number of these requested exemptions are for semi-permanent work zones. Activities within those work zones support numerous scopes, including tunnel construction, appendage construction, and civil restoration. Each of these work zones will need to remain in place for the following reasons:
a.Work activities are on the critical path for project completion.
b.Removal of these work zones would require new WTCP to be approved by DOT and BOE, and each would take a significant time commitment from the EOR to draft due to overlaps in each WTCP

2.The remaining items include intermittent lane closures for various work activities, all of which are necessary to ensure that larger work activities are done on schedule. This includes Decking Removal at Fairfax, in addition to future activities at La Brea and Western.

3.A full work stoppage during the Holiday Moratorium Period would severely impact the overall project schedule.

4.Work within the Cross Passage structures will need to continue to ensure that the new tunnels are ready for testing. A work stoppage here would severely impact the overall project schedule.

5.STS and its contractors regularly monitor settlement along the PLE1 alignment. Spot repairs and full replacements of damaged or dysfunctional instruments may require intermittent lane closures.

Reasons for requesting the Holiday Moratorium Exemption:

The above requested exemptions are for currently City approved work zones. Activities within those work zones support tunnel construction, station excavation, and utility realignment. Each of these work zones will need to remain in place for the following reasons:

- a. Work activities are on the critical path for project completion.
- b. Removal of the currently approved traffic control will require new Worksite Traffic Control Plans to be approved by the LADOT and LABOE and each of those approvals would take a significant amount of time to prepare and to coordinate with City agencies and stakeholders.
- c. Full suspension of the work during the Holiday Moratorium period could potentially delay the completion of the Project and delay its opening to the public.
- d. Full suspension of the work during the Holiday Moratorium period could add unnecessary costs to the Project: demobilization and remobilization of labor and equipment, potential extended overhead costs, etc.
- e. The Storm Drain and Sanitary Sewer realignment is essential to be completed to minimize the impact to the overall stakeholders.

Reasons for requesting Holiday Moratorium Exemption:

- 1) Completion of decking is essential so TPOG can get started on excavating to the bottom of excavation and station concrete work could commence and not delay the overall construction schedule.
